

# **Aviation Transport Security Amendment Regulation 2012 (No. 2)**<sup>1</sup>

### 1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Aviation Transport Security Amendment Regulation 2012 (No. 2).

## [1] Regulation 1.03, definition of *air security officer*, paragraph (a)

substitute

(a) a protective service officer, special protective service officer, member, or special member, of the Australian Federal Police who is directed by the Commissioner to carry out the duties of a position of air security officer; or
