Medical Indemnity (Prudential Supervision and Product Standards) Act 2003

Interpretation

In this Notice

APRA means the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority.

FRLI means the Federal Register of Legislative Instruments established under the Legislative Instruments Act 2003.

Note 1 Under subsection 13(9) of the Medical Indemnity (Prudential Supervision and Product Standards) Act 2003, APRA may, by legislative instrument, issue guidelines on the matters referred to in paragraphs 13(9)(a) to (d) of that Act.

Note 2 Under subsection 33(3) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* where an Act confers a power to make, grant or issue any instrument (including rules, regulations or by-laws) the power shall, unless the contrary intention appears, be construed as including a power exercisable in the like manner and subject to the like conditions (if any) to repeal, rescind, revoke, amend, or vary any such instrument.
