1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Telecommunications (Interception and Access) (Emergency Service Facilities — Northern Territory) Instrument 2012*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Revocation

The *Telecommunications (Interception and Access) (Emergency Service Facilities — Northern Territory) Instrument 2007* is revoked.

4 Definition

In this instrument:

Act means the *Telecommunications (Interception and Access) Act 1979*.

5 Emergency service facilities

For subsection 6 (2D) of the Act, each force or service mentioned in an item of the following table operates premises located in each geographical region mentioned in the item.
