**1 Name of regulation**

This regulation is the *Veterans' Entitlements Amendment Regulation 2012 (No. 1)*.

**2 Commencement**

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

**3 Amendment of *Veterans' Entitlements Regulations 1986***

Schedule 1 amends the *Veterans' Entitlements Regulations 1986*.
