

## Explanatory Statement: Determination 2012/10 Compensation for Loss of Office for Holders of Public Office

- 1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the provision of compensation for loss of office for a holder of a public office, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973* (the Act).
- 2. In making this determination the Tribunal has informed itself through consultation in accordance with established practice.
- 3. Any retrospective application of this determination is in accordance with subsection 12(2) of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003* as it does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth or an authority of the Commonwealth) to that person's disadvantage, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.
- 4. This Determination is compatible with the human rights or freedoms recognised or declared in the international instruments listed in section 3 of the *Human Rights (Parliamentary Scrutiny) Act 2011*. This Determination does not engage any of the applicable rights or freedoms.

## **PART 1 - GENERAL**

- 5. Clause 1.1 specifies the authority for the Determination.
- 6. Clause 1.2 sets the date of effect of the Determination.
- 7. Clause 1.3 specifies that the Determination supersedes Determination 2007/07 Compensation for Loss of Office for Public Office Holders which ceased to have effect on 30 June 2012.
- 8. Clause 1.4 and 1.5 are definitions of new terms, Reference Salary, at Clause 1.4 and Employer's Superannuation Contribution, at Clause 1.5.

## PART 2 - COMPENSATION FOR LOSS OF OFFICE

9. Part 2 sets out the entitlements for compensation for early loss of office which take effect on 1 July 2012.
