1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Ozone Protection and Synthetic Greenhouse Gas Management Amendment Regulation 2012 (No. 2)*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

3 Amendment of *Ozone Protection and Synthetic Greenhouse Gas Management Regulations 1995*

- (I) for a restricted refrigerant trading authorisation—ensures that any refrigerant in the holder's possession is handled only by the holder of a licence granted under regulation 131, 133 or 134 that entitles the holder to handle the refrigerant in the way in which it is being handled; and
