

# Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission Repeal Regulation 2012<sup>1</sup>

Select Legislative Instrument 2012 No. 219

## 1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission Repeal Regulation 2012.* 

## 2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day after it is registered.

## 3 Repeal

- (1) The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission Regulations (Statutory Rules 1992 No. 122) are repealed.
- (2) This regulation expires at the end of the day it commences as if it had been repealed by another legislative instrument.
