### **Approval — means of compliance with Airworthiness Directive for Bombardier aircraft**

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**1 Duration**

This instrument:

- (a) commences on the day of registration; and
- (b) ceases to have effect if Canadian Airworthiness Directive CF 2011-03R2 (the *AD*) is amended or cancelled.

**2 Application**

This instrument applies to any Bombardier Inc. aeroplane registered in Australia and engaged in commercial passenger-carrying operations within Australian territory (the *aircraft*).

**3 Approved means of compliance**

I approve for the aircraft, as a means of compliance with the AD other than that set out in the AD, the retention of any original chemical oxygen generator installed in any lavatory.

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
