SPECIFICATION OF OCCUPATIONS EXEMPT FROM LABOUR MARKET TESTING

(Section 140GBC)

I, *MICHAELIA CASH*, Assistant Minister for Immigration and Border Protection, acting under section 140GBC of the *Migration Act 1958* ('the Act') hereby:

- 1. SPECIFY for the purpose of paragraph 140GBC(4)(a) of the Act, all occupations that are classified in the ANZSCO as Skill Level 1¹; AND
- 2. SPECIFY for the purpose of paragraph 140GBC(4)(b) of the Act, all occupations that are classified in the ANZSCO as Skill Level 2²; AND
- 3. SPECIFY for the purpose of regulation 1.03 of the *Migration Regulations 1994* that the definition of ANZSCO is the Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics and current as at 1 July 2013.

This Instrument, IMMI 13/137, commences on 23 November 2013, immediately after the commencement of the *Migrations Amendment (Temporary Sponsored Visas) Act 2013*.
