**INSTRUMENT OF APPROVAL OF FALL-BACK REPORTING SYSTEMS
(INTERNATIONAL PASSENGER AIRCRAFT - PASSENGERS) 2015**

(Section 245K)

I, *MICHAEL PEZZULLO*, Secretary of the Department of Immigration and Border Protection, acting under section 245K of the *Migration Act 1958* (the Act):

1. REVOKE the Instrument of Approval of Fall-back Reporting System (International Passenger Aircraft - Passengers) (F2006B00352), signed on 19 December 2003; and
2. APPROVE the following systems:
 - (a) reporting to the Department of Immigration and Border Protection's Entry Operations Centre by telephone to either of the following telephone numbers in Australia:
 - (i) (02) 6264 1301; or
 - (ii) 1300 368 970; or
 - (b) reporting to the Entry Operations Centre by email: EOC@immi.gov.au; or
 - (c) reporting to the Entry Operations Centre by SITATEX to the address CBRIXCR; or
 - (d) APPchat;as the systems of reporting, for the purposes of fall-back reporting under Division 12B of Part 2 of the Act, for each passenger of an *international passenger aircraft* as defined in subregulation 3.13 of the *Migration Regulations 1994* (the Regulations); and
3. SPECIFY the information that is to be reported in respect of passengers of international passenger aircraft in Schedule 1 to this Instrument; and
4. SPECIFY the information that is to be reported in respect of passengers of international passenger aircraft in Schedule 2 to this Instrument.

This Instrument, IMMI 15/021 commences immediately after the commencement of *Migration Legislation Amendment (2015 Measures No. 2) Regulation 2015*.

| Item | Description |
|-------------|---|
| 1 | The flight number, port of arrival of the aircraft and the expected date of arrival of the aircraft. |
| 2 | Where the Operator has confirmed that the passenger has boarded the aircraft, each person holds: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li data-bbox="352 573 1362 658">(a) a travel document, other than an Australian or New Zealand passport, and a visa which is in effect that permit the person to travel to and enter Australia; or<li data-bbox="352 674 967 712">(b) a current Australian or New Zealand passport. |
| 3 | For each passenger who the Operator has not confirmed as falling within Item 2, whether the Operator has obtained up-lift approval from the Department of Immigration and Border Protection's Entry Operation Centre. |
