1 Name

This is the *Biosecurity (First Point of Entry—Lord Howe Island Port) Determination 2016.*

3 Authority

- (1) This instrument is made under subsection 229(1) of the *Biosecurity Act 2015*.
- (2) This instrument is made as permitted by subitem 1(1) of Schedule 3 to the *Biosecurity (Consequential Amendments and Transitional Provisions) Act 2015.*

4 Definitions

Note: A number of expressions used in this instrument are defined in the *Biosecurity Act 2015*, including the following:

- (a) goods;
- (b) vessel.

In this instrument:

goods means goods:

- (a) that are subject to biosecurity control; or
- (b) in relation to which an exposed goods order is in force.

vessel means vessels that are subject to biosecurity control.

Part 2—First point of entry

5 First point of entry—vessels

Lord Howe Island Port is a first point of entry for vessels.

6 First point of entry—goods

Lord Howe Island Port is **NOT** a first point of entry for goods.

Part 3—Biosecurity entry points

Note: No areas of Lord Howe Island Port are designated as biosecurity entry points.

Part 4—Conditions

Note: There are no specified conditions for Lord Howe Island Port.

Editorial changes

The *Legislation Act 2003* authorises First Parliamentary Counsel to make editorial and presentational changes to a compiled law in preparing a compilation of the law for registration. The changes must not change the effect of the law. Editorial changes take effect from the compilation registration date.

If the compilation includes editorial changes, the endnotes include a brief outline of the changes in general terms. Full details of any changes can be obtained from the Office of Parliamentary Counsel.

Misdescribed amendments

A misdescribed amendment is an amendment that does not accurately describe the amendment to be made. If, despite the misdescription, the amendment can be given effect as intended, the amendment is incorporated into the compiled law and the abbreviation "(md)" added to the details of the amendment included in the amendment history.

If a misdescribed amendment cannot be given effect as intended, the abbreviation "(md not incorp)" is added to the details of the amendment included in the amendment history.
