Consumer Protection Notice No. 6 of 2016

**EXTENSION OF THE EXTENDED BAN PERIOD FOR THE INTERIM BAN ON
HOVERBOARDS THAT DO NOT MEET SPECIFIC SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

I, KELLY O'DWYER, Minister for Small Business and Assistant Treasurer, pursuant to section 111(6) of the Australian Consumer Law, which is Schedule 2 to the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010*, extend the extended ban period for the interim ban titled '*Imposition of interim ban on hoverboards that do not meet specific safety requirements*' imposed via Consumer Protection Notice No. 3 of 2016 and extended via Consumer Protection Notice No. 5 of 2016, by a period of 30 days.

The interim ban period started on 19 March 2016 for a period of 60 days and was then extended for a further 30 days. The extended interim ban period ends on 16 June 2016.

The effect of this Notice is to extend the extended interim ban period by a further 30 days to 16 July 2016.

This Notice commences on 17 June 2016.
