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Part 1 Preliminary

1. Name of Declaration

This Declaration is the *Declaration of Quality Assurance Activity under section 124X of the Health Insurance Act 1973 – QAA 8/2016*.

2. Commencement

Description:

The Australian and New Zealand Intensive Care Society (ANZICS) Centre for Outcome and Resource Evaluation, run by ANZICS, provides for the auditing and benchmarking of Intensive Care Unit (ICU) performance across Australia and New Zealand through the following registries:

- (a) Adult Patient Database;
- (b) Paediatric Intensive Care Registry;
- (c) Critical Care Resources Registry; and
- (d) ICU Central line Associated Bloodstream Infection Registry.
