## CLASS OF PERSONS FOR TEMPORARY WORK (INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS) (CLASS GD) VISA 2016/110

 $(subparagraph\ 1234(2)(a)(i))$ 

- I, *PETER DUTTON*, Minister for Immigration and Border Protection, acting under subregulation 2.07(5) of the *Migration Regulations* 1994 (the Regulations):
- 1. REVOKE Instrument IMMI 16/032 (F2016L00576), Class of Persons 2016/032, signed on 26 April 2016;
- 2. SPECIFY for the purposes of subparagraph 1234(2)(a)(i) of Schedule 1 to the Regulations, the following classes of persons:
  - a. Fulbright Scholars of the United States of America;
  - b. participants in the Pacific Microstates Northern Australia Worker Pilot Programme;
  - c. persons to whom privileges and immunities are, or are expected to be, accorded under one or both of the following Acts:
    - i. the International Organisations (Privileges and Immunities) Act 1963; or
    - ii. the Overseas Missions (Privileges and Immunities) Act 1995 and who are expected to be recommended by the Foreign Minister for the grant of a visa; and
  - d. persons who hold a valid diplomatic, official or service passport and who hold a third person note of support for the application from the government, or a government agency, of the applicant's home country.

This Instrument, Class of Persons for Temporary Work (International Relations) (Class GD) Visa 2016/110, IMMI 16/110, commences immediately after the commencement of the *Migration Amendment (Temporary Activity Visas) Regulation 2016*.
