1 Name

This instrument is the *Veterans' Entitlements (Exempt Lump Sum – Compensation Payment for Australian Prisoners of War in Europe) Determination 2017*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after registration.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under paragraph 5H(12)(c) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* (VEA).

4 Revocation

The *Veterans' Entitlements Income (Exempt Lump Sum - Ex Gratia Payment for Australian Prisoners of War in Europe) Determination* (Instrument No.R16/2007) dated 31 May 2007 is revoked.

5 Definitions

In this instrument:

“compensation payment for Australian Prisoners of War in Europe” means a one-off payment made under Schedule 5 of the *Social Security and Veterans' Affairs Legislation Amendment (One-off Payments and Other 2007 Budget Measures) Act 2007*;

“income support supplement” means the payment called the income support supplement payable under Part IIIA of the VEA;

“service pension” has the same meaning as in subsection 5Q(1) of the VEA.

6 Exempt lump sum

If a person or a person's partner receives a *compensation payment for Australian Prisoners of War in Europe* and the person is eligible for, or in receipt of a *service pension* or *income support supplement*, then the amount of the *compensation payment for Australian Prisoners of War in Europe* received by the person or the person's partner is an exempt lump sum.
