1	Artificial Intelligence Capability Program	Financial assistance to meet a need for national coordination and leadership in relation to Australia's artificial intelligence and machine learning capability by providing funding to Standards Australia to develop a strategic framework for developing artificial intelligence standards.

6 Specified legislative power

For the purposes of subsection 33(3) of the Act, the power of the Parliament to make laws with respect to measures that are peculiarly adapted to the government of a nation and cannot otherwise be carried on for the benefit of the nation is specified.
