1 Name of rule

The name of this rule is the *Parking Permit Fees Rule 2019*.

2 Commencement

This rule commences on 1 July 2019.

3 Repeal

The Parking Permit Fees Rule 2018 is repealed.

4 Determination of fees

The *National Land (Road Transport) Ordinance 2014* applies ACT Laws (generally about pay parking) to National Land. The Minister has the authority to determine fees under Section 96 (determination of fees, charges and other amounts) of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999 (ACT)*.

The fee payable for a parking permit mentioned in an item in column 2 of schedule 1 is the amount for that item in column 3.

The fees are effective from the date specified in column 3 of Schedule 1.

5 Payment of fees

A fee listed in schedule 1 is payable to the Commonwealth by the applicant for the thing to which the application relates.

6 Definitions

In this instrument:

fee includes a charge or other amount.

parking permit—see:

- (a) the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2017, dictionary; and
- (b) the *Parking Permit Rule 2014* made pursuant to subsection 11 of the *National Land (Road Transport) Ordinance 2014.*

1	Grant or renewal of a 'construction zone' parking permit	\$14.50 per ticket parking space per business day
2	Grant or renewal of a 'special event' parking permit	\$14.50 per ticket parking space per business day
