VARIATION OF THE ROADS TO RECOVERY LIST 2019

Instrument No. 2019/4

I, OLIVER HOLM, General Manager, South East Infrastructure Investment, Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Cities and Regional Development, under Sections 88(2A) of the *National Land Transport Act 2014* (the Act), vary the *Roads to Recovery List 2019* which was made by the Minister on 31 October 2018, and amended by Instrument No. 2019/2 made on 1 July 2019 and 2019/3 made on 29 July 2019 as follows:
