nominee, in relation to a nomination to which regulation 2.73B of the Regulations applies, means the nominee mentioned in that regulation.

Regional Occupation List: see section 7.

Regulations means the Migration Regulations 1994.

university lecturer includes the following:

- (a) a research associate in a university;
- (b) a research fellow in a university.

5 Specification of occupations

- (1) For the purposes of subregulation 2.72C(11) of the Regulations:
 - (a) an occupation listed in column 1 of an item of the Medium and Long-term Strategic Skills List or the Regional Occupation List is specified; and
 - (b) the ANZSCO code listed in column 2 of the item is specified for the occupation; and
 - (c) subject to subsection (2) of this section, the occupation applies to a nominee if the tasks of the occupation that are to be performed by the nominee correspond to the tasks set out in that ANZSCO code.
