1 Name

This instrument is the Macquarie Island Toothfish Fishery (Total Allowable Catch) Determination 2020.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 15 April 2020.

3 Authority

This instrument is made pursuant to paragraph 17(6)(aa) of the *Fisheries Management Act 1991* under section 11 of the *Macquarie Island Toothfish Fishery Management Plan 2006*.

4 Cessation

This instrument ceases as if it was revoked on 15 April 2022 unless earlier revoked.

5 Definitions

A term used in this instrument that is defined for the purposes of the *Macquarie Island Toothfish Fishery Management Plan 2006* (the *Plan*) has the same meaning in this instrument as it has in the Plan.

Note:

Terms defined in the Fisheries Management Act 1991 have the same meanings in this instrument

6 Schedules

Each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.

7 Determination of total allowable catch

- (1) The total allowable catch for Patagonian toothfish and catch limits for other species in the Macquarie Island Toothfish Fishery for the 2020/2021 fishing year, commencing on 15 April 2020 and ending on 14 April 2021, and the 2021/22 fishing year, commencing on 15 April 2021 and ending on 14 April 2022 are:
 - (a) 555 tonnes for each fishing year for Patagonian toothfish (Dissostichus eleginoides); and
 - (b) 50 tonnes for each fishing year for each of the other species in the Macquarie Island Toothfish Fishery.
