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1 Name

This instrument is the *Criminal Code (Terrorist Organisation—Boko Haram) Regulations 2020*.

2 Commencement

- (1) Each provision of this instrument specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect according to its terms.

5 Terrorist organisation—Boko Haram

- (1) For the purposes of paragraph (b) of the definition of **terrorist organisation** in subsection 102.1(1) of the *Criminal Code*, the organisation known as Boko Haram is specified.
- (2) Boko Haram is also known by the following names:
- Group of the Followers of the Prophet for Propagation and Holy Struggle;
 - Jama'at Ahl al-Sunnah lil-Da'awa wal-Jihad;
 - Jama'atu Ahlis Sunna Lidda'awati Wal-Jihad;
 - Nigerian Mujahideen;
 - Nigerian Taliban;
 - People Committed to the Propagation of the Prophet's Teachings and Jihad;
 - Western Education is Forbidden;
 - Yusuffiya Movement;
