#### 1 Name

This instrument is the *Hearing Services Program (Voucher) Amendment Instrument (No. 2) 2020.* 

#### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2021.

## 56 Transitional provisions relating to duration of vouchers

A voucher issued under this instrument that remains in force at the commencement date of the *Hearing Services Program (Voucher) Amendment Instrument (No. 2) 2020* is taken to have been issued under this instrument as amended.

Note:

The Hearing Services Program (Voucher) Amendment Instrument (No. 2) 2020 extended the duration of vouchers from 3 years to 5 years. Accordingly, vouchers that were issued before the amendments commenced, but remained in force on 1 July 2021, will be valid for 5 years.
