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1 Name

This is the Amendment Statement of Principles concerning *Guillain-Barre syndrome (Reasonable Hypothesis)* (No. 57 of 2021).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 24 May 2021.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under subsections 196B(2) and (8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*.

4 Amendment

The Statement of Principles concerning *Guillain-Barre syndrome (Reasonable Hypothesis)* (No. 23 of 2018) (Federal Register of Legislation No. F2018L00187) is amended in the following manner:

Section	Amendment
9(1)	Delete the words "with an organism".
Schedule 1 – Dictionary	In paragraph (l) in the definition of " specified list of infections ", insert the word "virus" after the word "measles".
Schedule 1 – Dictionary	After paragraph (o) in the definition of " specified list of infections ", insert the following paragraph: (oa) severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2);
Schedule 1 – Dictionary	Insert the following note to the definition of " specified list of infections ": Note: SARS-CoV-2 is the virus which causes coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).
