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## About this compilation

### This compilation

This is a compilation of the *Therapeutic Goods (Exempt Monographs) Determination 2021* that shows the text of the law as amended and in force on 1 October 2024 (the **compilation date**).

The notes at the end of this compilation (the **endnotes**) include information about amending laws and the amendment history of provisions of the compiled law.

### Uncommenced amendments

The effect of uncommenced amendments is not shown in the text of the compiled law. ### Application, saving and transitional provisions for provisions and amendments

If the operation of a provision or amendment of the compiled law is affected by an application, saving or transitional provision that is not included in this compilation, details are included in the endnotes.

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## 1 Name

This instrument is the *Therapeutic Goods (Exempt Monographs) Determination 2021*.

## 3 Authority

This instrument is made under section 3C of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989*.

## 4 Definitions

Note: A number of expressions used in this instrument are defined in subsection 3(1) of the Act, including the following:

- (c) standard;
- (d) therapeutic goods;
- (e) United States Pharmacopeia-National Formulary.

In this instrument:

*Act* means the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989*.

## 5 Exemption

For subsection 3C(1) of the Act, in relation to each item mentioned in the table in Schedule 1, the monographs specified in column 2, in the pharmacopoeia specified in column 3, are exempt for the purposes of paragraph (b), (c) or (d) of the definition of *standard* in subsection 3(1) of the Act, in relation to the therapeutic goods specified in column 4.

### Legislation history and amendment history—Endnotes 3 and 4

Amending laws are annotated in the legislation history and amendment history.

The legislation history in endnote 3 provides information about each law that has amended (or will amend) the compiled law. The information includes commencement details for amending laws and details of any application, saving or transitional provisions that are not included in this compilation.

The amendment history in endnote 4 provides information about amendments at the provision (generally section or equivalent) level. It also includes information about any provision of the compiled law that has been repealed in accordance with a provision of the law.

### Misdescribed amendments

A misdescribed amendment is an amendment that does not accurately describe how an amendment is to be made. If, despite the misdescription, the amendment can be given effect as intended, then the misdescribed amendment can be incorporated through an editorial change made under section 15V of the *Legislation Act 2003*.

If a misdescribed amendment cannot be given effect as intended, the amendment is not incorporated and “(md not incorp)” is added to the amendment history.
