*Amendment of List of Exempt Native Specimens – Queensland Coral Fishery,
October 2021*

I, SUSSAN LEY, Minister for the Environment, pursuant to subsection 303DC(1)(a) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act), hereby amend the list of exempt native specimens established under section 303DB of the EPBC Act by **deleting** from the list specimens and any notations specified in **Schedule 1**, and by **including** in the list specimens and associated restrictions or conditions as set out in **Schedule 2**.

This instrument is a legislative instrument for the purposes of the *Legislation Act 2003*.

The instrument commences the day after it is registered.
