5 Reservoirs included in the Rankin Trend

- (1) For the purposes of paragraph 6CA(1B)(b) of the Act, the reservoirs, or groups of reservoirs, known as the following are specified:
- (a) Persephone;
 - (b) Greater Western Flank-2.
- (2) Paragraph (1)(a) applies on and after 30 July 2017.
- (3) Paragraph (1)(b) applies on and after 25 October 2018.
