### 4 Amendment

The Statement of Principles concerning *Guillain-Barre syndrome (Balance of Probabilities)* (No. 24 of 2018) (Federal Register of Legislation No. F2018L00187) is amended in the following manner:

Section	Amendment
9(5)	Replace the existing factor in subsection 9(5) with the following:
	receiving a vaccine from the specified list of vaccines within the two months before the clinical onset of Guillain-Barre syndrome;
	Note: <i>specified list of vaccines</i> is defined in the Schedule 1 – Dictionary.
Schedule 1 –	Insert the following definition of "specified list of
Dictionary	vaccines" in alphabetical order.
	specified list of vaccines means:
	<ul> <li>(a) adenovirus vector coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) vaccine;</li> <li>(b) influenza vaccine; or</li> </ul>
	(c) nerve tissue derived rabies vaccine.
	Note: Examples of adenovirus vector COVID-19 vaccines include:
	<ul> <li>(a) Ad26.COV2.S (Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine);</li> <li>(b) ChAdOx1 nCoV-19 (Vaxzevria, Oxford/Astra-Zeneca);</li> <li>(c) Gam-COVID-Vac (Sputnik V, Sputnik Light); and</li> <li>(d) AD5-nCOV (Convidecia).</li> </ul>
