1 Name

This is the Amendment Statement of Principles concerning *Guillain-Barre syndrome (Balance of Probabilities)* (No. 75 of 2022).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 25 July 2022.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under subsections 196B(3) and (8) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*.

4 Amendment

The Statement of Principles concerning *Guillain-Barre syndrome (Balance of Probabilities)* (No. 24 of 2018) (Federal Register of Legislation No. F2018L00187) is amended in the following manner:

9(5)	<p><i>Replace the existing factor in subsection 9(5) with the following:</i></p> <p>receiving a vaccine from the specified list of vaccines within the two months before the clinical onset of Guillain-Barre syndrome;</p> <p>Note: specified list of vaccines is defined in the Schedule 1 – Dictionary.</p>
Schedule 1 – Dictionary	<p><i>Insert the following definition of "specified list of vaccines" in alphabetical order:</i></p> <p>specified list of vaccines means:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) adenovirus vector coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) vaccine;(b) influenza vaccine; or(c) nerve tissue derived rabies vaccine. <p>Note: Examples of adenovirus vector COVID-19 vaccines include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) Ad26.COV2.S (Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine);(b) ChAdOx1 nCoV-19 (Vaxzevria, Oxford/Astra-Zeneca);(c) Gam-COVID-Vac (Sputnik V, Sputnik Light); and(d) AD5-nCOV (Convidecia).
