1 Name

This instrument is the Western Tuna and Billfish Fishery Total Allowable Commercial Catch Determination 2023.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 February 2023.

3 Authority

This instrument is made pursuant to paragraph 17(6)(aa) of the *Fisheries* Management Act 1991 and subsection 11(1) of the Western Tuna and Billfish Fishery Management Plan 2005 (the Plan).

4 Definitions

A term used in this instrument that is defined for the purposes of the Plan has the same meaning in this instrument as it has in the Plan.

Note: Terms defined in the *Fisheries Management Act 1991* have the same meaning in this instrument.

5 Cessation

This instrument ceases on 1 February 2024.

6 Total Allowable Commercial Catch

The total allowable commercial catch for quota species for the Western Tuna and Billfish Fishery fishing season commencing on 1 February 2023 and ending on 31 January 2024 is:

Quota species	Total Allowable Commercial Catch
Bigeye Tuna	2,000 tonnes Whole weight
Broadbill Swordfish	3,000 tonnes Whole weight
Striped Marlin	125 tonnes Whole weight
Yellowfin Tuna	2,000 tonnes Whole weight
