1 Name

This instrument is the *Criminal Code (Terrorist Organisation—Islamic State East Asia) Regulations 2023*.

2 Commencement

5 Terrorist organisation—Islamic State East Asia

- (1) For the purposes of paragraph (b) of the definition of **terrorist organisation** in subsection 102.1(1) of the *Criminal Code*, the organisation known as Islamic State East Asia is specified.
- (2) Islamic State East Asia is also known by the following names:
- Ansharul Khilafah Philippines;
 - Bangsamoro Islamic Freedom Fighters-Abubakar;
 - Bangsamoro Islamic Freedom Fighters-Bungos;
 - Dawlah Islamiyah-Lanao;
 - Dawlah Islamiyah-Maguindanao;
 - Dawlah Islamiyah-Torayfie Group;
 - Dawlatul Islamiyah Waliyatul Masrik;
 - Islamic State East Asia Province;

- (i) Islamic State in Iraq and Syria-Philippines;
- (j) Islamic State Lanao;
- (k) Islamic State-Philippines;
- (l) Islamic State Lanao;
- (m) Jama'atu al-Muhajirin wal Ansar fil Filibin;

- (p) Syuful Khalifah Fi Luzon;
