Each of the following is a declared child protection State or Territory for the purposes of Part 3AA of the Act:

- (a) New South Wales;
- (b) Victoria;
- (c) Queensland;
- (d) Western Australia;
- (e) South Australia;
- (f) the Northern Territory.

Part 3—Recognised State/Territory authority

6 Recognised State/Territory authority

The Department of Health of the Northern Territory is a recognised State/Territory authority for the purposes of Part 3AA of the Act.
