# Schedule 1—Amendments

## Remuneration Tribunal (Members' Fees and Allowances) Regulation 2016

### 1 Section 6

Repeal the section, substitute:

#### 6 Fees

- (1) For the purposes of section 12 of the Act, the fees set out in this section are prescribed.
- (2) For the period between 1 July 2022 and 30 June 2023, the fees are:
  - (a) for the President—\$135,117 per year; and
  - (b) for other members—\$46,069 per year.
- (3) For the period on and after 1 July 2023, the fees are:
  - (a) for the President—\$140,522 per year; and
  - (b) for other members—\$47,912 per year.
