Omit the dot point list of protein engineered variants of enzymes in the note, substitute:

- Endo-1,4- β -xylanase, protein engineered variant;
- Fructan β -fructosidase, protein engineered variant;
- Glucoamylase, protein engineered variant;
- Maltogenic α -amylase, protein engineered variant;
- Protein engineered enzymes used in the manufacture of various steviol glycosides.
