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### 1 Name

This instrument is the Financial Framework (Supplementary Powers)

Amendment (Foreign Affairs and Trade Measures No. 1) Regulations 2025.

# **Schedule 1—Amendments**

# Financial Framework (Supplementary Powers) Regulations 1997

## 1 Part 4 of Schedule 1AB (table item 417)

Repeal the item, substitute:

417 Support for the Cook Islands

To provide ongoing financial assistance to, or for the benefit of, the Cook Islands, including for initiatives relating to regional issues in the Pacific.

This objective has the effect it would have if it were limited to measures:

(a) with respect to places, persons, matters or things external to Australia; or

(b) with respect to the relations of the Commonwealth with the islands of the Pacific.

# 2 In the appropriate position in Part 4 of Schedule 1AB (table)

Insert:

709 Support for the Republic of Nauru

To provide financial assistance and other forms of support to, or for the benefit of, Nauru, in connection with the Nauru–Australia Treaty signed on 9 December 2024, as a measure with respect to external affairs (within the meaning of paragraph 51(xxix) of the Constitution).

This objective also has the effect it would have if it were limited to measures with respect to the relations of the Commonwealth with the islands of the Pacific.
