Schedule 1—Amendments

Biosecurity Regulation 2016

1 Paragraph 109(4)(d)

Repeal the paragraph, substitute:

- (d) in relation to a biosecurity matter prescribed by any of items 13, 13AA and 13AB in the table—the person who is covered by the relevant arrangement or agreement, or the relevant arrangements or agreements, to which the charge relates;
