1 Name

This instrument is the Migration (International trade obligations relating to labour market testing) Amendment (CEPA) Determination 2025.

2 Commencement

- (1) This instrument commences on the later of:
 - (a) the day after this instrument is registered; and
 - (b) immediately after Schedule 1 to the Customs Amendment (Australia-United Arab Emirates Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement Implementation) Act 2025 commences.
- (2) However, this instrument does not commence at all if the event mentioned in paragraph (1)(b) does not occur.

3 Authority

This instrument is made under subsection 140GBA(2) of the Migration Act 1958.

4 Schedules

Each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.
