4 *Object*

- 5 (1) The object of this item is to provide for a CGT roll-over so as to
6 facilitate the exercise by CSC of its powers under section 18 of the
7 *Military Superannuation and Benefits Act 1991* in relation to the MSB
8 Fund to operate a pooled superannuation trust, known as the ARIA
9 Investments Trust, that is used for investing the assets of the MSB
10 Fund.

11 *Roll-over*

- 12 (2) There is a roll-over if:
- 13 (a) after 30 June 2011 and on or before 1 July 2012 (or such later
14 date as is prescribed by the regulations), one or more CGT
15 events happen because CSC ceases to hold CGT assets of the
16 MSB Fund; and
- 17 (b) because of the cessation, CGT assets (the *identical assets*)
18 that, together, are identical to all the CGT assets of the MSB
19 Fund just before the happening of the CGT events start to be
20 held:
- 21 (i) by the trustee (the *transferee trustee*) of the ARIA
22 Investments Trust (whether or not all the identical assets
23 were assets of the MSB Fund just before the CGT
24 events); and
- 25 (ii) after 30 June 2011 and on or before 1 July 2012 (or such
26 later date as is prescribed by the regulations); and
- 27 (c) the cessation is part of a scheme under which CGT assets of
28 the MSB Fund are replaced with units in the ARIA
29 Investments Trust.

30 Note: The transferee trustee may be CSC: see subsection 960-100(3) of the *Income Tax*
31 *Assessment Act 1997*.

- 32 (3) A capital gain or capital loss CSC makes from each of the CGT events
33 is disregarded.

- 1 (4) For the transferee trustee, the first element of the cost base of each of
2 the identical assets the transferee trustee holds is the cost base of the
3 corresponding asset for CSC at the time of the relevant CGT event.
- 4 (5) For the transferee trustee, the first element of the reduced cost base of
5 each of the identical assets the transferee trustee holds is the reduced
6 cost base of the corresponding asset for CSC at the time of the relevant
7 CGT event.
- 8 (6) For the purposes of the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997*, a roll-over
9 covered by this item is taken to be a same-asset roll-over.

10 *Interpretation*

- 11 (7) An expression used in this item and in the *Income Tax Assessment Act*
12 *1997* has the same meaning in this item as it has in that Act.

13 **20 Amending instruments may be retrospective**

22 commencement as if it were a delegation made by the CEO
23 of ComSuper under section 25 of the *ComSuper Act 2011*;
24 and
25 (d) any other delegation under a superannuation law that was in
26 force immediately before commencement continues in force
27 on and after commencement as if it were a delegation made
28 by CSC under section 36 of the *Governance of Australian*
29 *Government Superannuation Schemes Act 2011*; and
30 (e) any sub-delegation to the Commissioner for Superannuation
31 that was in force immediately before commencement
32 continues in force on and after commencement as if it were a
33 sub-delegation to the CEO of ComSuper under section 36 of
34 the *Governance of Australian Government Superannuation*

36 (f) any sub-delegation to a member of the staff assisting the

6 that was in force immediately before commencement
7 continues in force on and after commencement as if it were a
8 sub-delegation by the CEO of ComSuper under section 36 of
9 the *Governance of Australian Government Superannuation*
10 *Schemes Act 2011*; and
- 11 (h) any sub-delegation by a member of the staff assisting the
12 Commissioner for Superannuation in the performance of his
13 or her functions under a superannuation law that was in force
14 immediately before commencement continues in force on and
15 after commencement as if it were a sub-delegation by a
16 member of the staff of ComSuper under section 36 of the
17 *Governance of Australian Government Superannuation*
18 *Schemes Act 2011*; and
- 19 (i) any other sub-delegation under a superannuation law that was
20 in force immediately before commencement continues in
21 force on and after commencement as if it were a
22 sub-delegation made under section 36 of the *Governance of*
23 *Australian Government Superannuation Schemes Act 2011*.
- 24 (2) Subitem (1) does not apply to a delegation made by a Minister or under
25 a governing deed.

26 *Delegations made by a Minister*

- 27 (3) Despite the amendment of section 51 of the *Military Superannuation*
28 *and Benefits Act 1991* by Schedule 1 to this Act:
- 29 (a) any delegation by the Minister to the MSB Board that was in
30 force under that section immediately before commencement
31 continues in force on and after commencement as if it were a
32 delegation made by the Minister to CSC under that section as
33 amended by Schedule 1 to this Act; and
- 34 (b) any delegation by the Minister to the Commissioner for
35 Superannuation that was in force under that section
36 immediately before commencement continues in force on and
37 after commencement as if it were a delegation made by the

- 1 Minister to the CEO of ComSuper under that section as
2 amended by Schedule 1 to this Act; and
- 3 (c) any delegation by the Minister to a member of the staff
4 assisting the Commissioner for Superannuation in the
5 performance of his or her functions under the *Military*
6 *Superannuation and Benefits Act 1991* that was in force
7 under that section immediately before commencement
8 continues in force on and after commencement as if it were a
9 delegation made by the Minister to a member of the staff of
10 ComSuper under that section as amended by Schedule 1 to
11 this Act; and
- 12 (d) any delegation to an APS employee in the Defence
13 Department or an officer of the Defence Force that was in
14 force under that section immediately before commencement
15 continues in force on and after commencement as if it were a
16 delegation made by the Minister to an APS employee in the
17 Defence Department or officer, as the case may be, under
18 that section as amended by Schedule 1 to this Act.
- 19 (4) Despite the amendment of:
- 20 (a) section 165 of the *Superannuation Act 1976* by Schedule 1 to
21 this Act; and
- 22 (b) section 47 of the *Superannuation Act 1990* by Schedule 1 to
23 this Act; and
- 24 (c) section 33 of the *Superannuation Act 2005* by Schedule 1 to
25 this Act;
- 26 the following paragraphs have effect:
- 27 (d) any delegation by the Minister to ARIA that was in force
28 under any of those sections immediately before
29 commencement continues in force on and after
30 commencement as if it were a delegation made by the
31 Minister to CSC under the relevant section as amended by
32 Schedule 1 to this Act;
- 33 (e) any delegation by the Minister to the Commissioner for
34 Superannuation that was in force under any of those sections
35 immediately before commencement continues in force on and
36 after commencement as if it were a delegation made by the
37 Minister to the CEO of ComSuper under the relevant section
38 as amended by Schedule 1 to this Act;

- 1 (f) any delegation by the Minister to a member of the staff
2 assisting the Commissioner for Superannuation in the
3 performance of his or her functions under any of the Acts
4 mentioned in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) that was in force
5 under any of those sections immediately before
6 commencement continues in force on and after
7 commencement as if it were a delegation made by the
8 Minister to a member of the staff of ComSuper under the
9 relevant section as amended by Schedule 1 to this Act;
- 10 (g) any delegation by the Minister to an APS employee in the
11 Finance Department that was in force under any of those
12 sections immediately before commencement continues in
13 force on and after commencement as if it were a delegation
14 made by the Minister to an APS employee in the Finance
15 Department under the relevant section as amended by
16 Schedule 1 to this Act.

17 *Delegations made under a governing deed*

- 18 (5) For the purposes of a governing deed:
- 19 (a) any delegation by the Minister to the Board that was in force
20 immediately before commencement continues in force on and
21 after commencement as if it were a delegation made by the
22 Minister to CSC under the relevant governing deed; and
- 23 (b) any delegation by the Minister to the Commissioner for
24 Superannuation that was in force immediately before
25 commencement continues in force on and after
26 commencement as if it were a delegation made by the
27 Minister to the CEO of ComSuper under the relevant
28 governing deed; and
- 29 (c) any other delegation to the Commissioner for Superannuation
30 that was in force immediately before commencement
31 continues in force on and after commencement as if it were a
32 delegation made by CSC to the CEO of ComSuper under the
33 relevant governing deed; and
- 34 (d) any delegation by the Minister to a member of the staff
35 assisting the Commissioner for Superannuation that was in
36 force immediately before commencement continues in force
37 on and after commencement as if it were a delegation made
38 by the Minister to a member of the staff of ComSuper under
39 the relevant governing deed; and

- 1 (e) any delegation to a member of the staff assisting the
2 Commissioner for Superannuation in the performance of his
3 or her functions under a superannuation law that was in force
4 immediately before commencement continues in force on and
5 after commencement as if it were a delegation made by CSC
6 to a member of the staff of ComSuper under the relevant
7 governing deed; and
8 (f) any other delegation that was in force immediately before
9 commencement continues in force on and after
10 commencement as if it were a delegation made by CSC under
11 the relevant governing deed; and
12 (g) any sub-delegation to the Commissioner for Superannuation
13 that was in force immediately before commencement
14 continues in force on and after commencement as if it were a
15 sub-delegation to the CEO of ComSuper under the relevant
16 governing deed; and
17 (h) any sub-delegation to a member of the staff assisting the
18 Commissioner for Superannuation that was in force
19 immediately before commencement continues in force on and
20 after commencement as if it were a sub-delegation to a
21 member of the staff of ComSuper under the relevant
22 governing deed; and
23 (i) any sub-delegation by the Commissioner for Superannuation
24 that was in force immediately before commencement
25 continues in force on and after commencement as if it were a
26 sub-delegation by the CEO of ComSuper under the relevant
27 governing deed; and
28 (j) any sub-delegation by a member of the staff assisting the
29 Commissioner for Superannuation that was in force
30 immediately before commencement continues in force on and
31 after commencement as if it were a sub-delegation by a
32 member of the staff of ComSuper under the relevant
33 governing deed; and
34 (k) any other sub-delegation that was in force immediately
35 before commencement continues in force on and after
36 commencement as if it were a sub-delegation made under the
37 relevant governing deed.

38 **23 Saving of existing declarations**

1 Despite the repeal and substitution of subsection 13(1) of the
2 *Superannuation Act 2005* by Schedule 1 to this Act, any declaration that
3 was in force immediately before commencement continues in force on
4 and after commencement as if it were a declaration made under
5 subparagraph 13(1)(a)(ii) of the *Superannuation Act 2005* as in force
6 after commencement.

7 **24 Transfer of custody of records**

- 8 (1) Subitem (2) applies to any records or documents that, immediately
9 before commencement, were in the custody of the Commissioner for
10 Superannuation.
- 11 (2) The records and documents are to be transferred into the custody of the
12 CEO of ComSuper at or after commencement.

13 **25 Certificates taken to be authentic**

14 A document that appears to be a certificate made or issued under a
15 particular provision of this Schedule:

- 16 (a) is taken to be such a certificate; and
17 (b) is taken to have been properly given;

18 unless the contrary is established.

19 **26 Special Accounts**

20 *Australian Reward Investment Alliance Special Account*

- 21 (1) There is payable to CSC, at commencement, an amount equal to the
22 credit balance of the Australian Reward Investment Alliance Special
23 Account immediately before commencement, and the Consolidated
24 Revenue Fund is appropriated accordingly.

25 *Commonwealth Superannuation Administration Special Account*

- 26 (2) An amount equal to:
27 (a) the credit balance of the Commonwealth Superannuation
28 Administration Special Account immediately before
29 commencement;
30 (b) less the amount mentioned in subitem (3);
31 is, after commencement, to be credited to the ComSuper Special
32 Account.

- 1 (3) There is payable to CSC, at commencement, an amount equal to the
2 amount held in Commonwealth Superannuation Administration Special
3 Account on behalf of the MSB Board immediately before
4 commencement, and the Consolidated Revenue Fund is appropriated
5 accordingly.

6 **27 Validation of audit fees paid**

- 7 (1) This item applies if, before commencement, the financial statements of
8 an Australian government superannuation scheme were audited by the
9 Auditor-General.
- 10 (2) ARIA is taken always to have been liable to pay audit fees for an audit
11 of the financial statements of the CSS, PSS or PSSAP for a financial
12 year beginning on or after 1 July 2006 and ending before 1 July 2011.
- 13 (3) The CSS Board is taken always to have been liable to pay audit fees for
14 an audit of the financial statements of the CSS for a financial year
15 beginning on or after 1 July 1997 and ending before 1 July 2006.
- 16 (4) The PSS Board is taken always to have been liable to pay audit fees for
17 an audit of the financial statements of the PSS for a financial year
18 beginning on or after 1 July 1997 and ending before 1 July 2006.
- 19 (5) The MSB Board is taken always to have been liable to pay audit fees for
20 an audit of the financial statements of the MSB for a financial year
21 beginning on or after 1 July 1997 and ending before 1 July 2011.
- 22 (6) If any payment claims or payment claims for instalments were issued by
23 the Auditor-General in respect of an audit to which this item applies, the
24 Auditor-General is taken always to have had the power to issue the
25 payment claims.

26 **28 Regulations**

- 27 (1) The Governor-General may make regulations prescribing matters:
28 (a) required or permitted by this Schedule to be prescribed; or
29 (b) necessary or convenient to be prescribed for carrying out or
30 giving effect to this Schedule.
- 31 (2) In particular, regulations may be made prescribing matters of a
32 transitional nature (including prescribing any saving or application
33 provisions) relating to the amendments or repeals made by this Act.
