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**A Bill for an Act to amend the *Food Standards Australia New Zealand Act 1991*, and for related purposes**

The Parliament of Australia enacts:

**1 Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *Food Standards Australia New Zealand Amendment (Forum on Food Regulation and Other Measures) Act 2015*.

**2 Commencement**

- (1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with

- (3) The ***food industry fields of expertise*** are the following:
- (a) the food industry;
  - (b) food processing or retailing;
  - (c) primary food production;
  - (d) small business;
  - (e) international trade;
  - (f) government;
  - (g) food regulation.

*Requirements for appointments—consumer rights members, science and public health members and food industry members*

- (4) For the purposes of item 4, 5 or 6 of the table, this subsection applies if:
- (a) the person is:
    - (i) nominated by an organisation or public body from which the Minister sought nominations and which was established in Australia or New Zealand for purposes relating to one or more of the fields of expertise to which subparagraph (1)(a)(ii) applies; or
    - (ii) selected in accordance with a competitive selection process that covers Australia and New Zealand; and
  - (b) the Forum on Food Regulation agrees to the appointment.

*Numbers of appointments*

- (5) The Minister must appoint, under subsection (1), each of the members mentioned in column 1 of the table, such that:
- (a) the total number of consumer rights members, science and public health members and food industry members is 7; and

- (b) at least one science and public health member is a person who the Minister is satisfied is suitably qualified to be a member because of the person's expertise in one or more fields primarily relating to science; and
- (c) at least one science and public health member is a person who the Minister is satisfied is suitably qualified to be a member because of the person's expertise in one or more fields primarily relating to public health.
