PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable the Earl of Hopetoun, a Member of His
Australia Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council, Knight of the Most Ancient and Most
to wit. Noble Order of the Thistle, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of
HOPETOUN. Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Grand Cross of the Royal Victorian Order,
(L.S.) Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by the *Excise Act 1901* it is enacted that "material" in that Act, except where otherwise clearly intended, includes all material used in the manufacture of excisable goods and declared by proclamation to be material within the meaning of that Act: Now, therefore, I, John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, the Governor-General aforesaid, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by the said Act, do hereby declare that Sugar-cane is material within the meaning of the said Act except as aforesaid.

Given at Melbourne, in the State of Victoria, this ninth day of October, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and one, in the first year of His Majesty's reign.
