### ORDER

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Sir Ronald Craufurd Munro Ferguson, a Member of His Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Our Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief in and over Our Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by the War Precautions (Prices Adjustment) Regulations 1916 it is amongst other things provided that the Governor-General may from time to time, on the recommendation of the Board, determine the maximum prices which may be charged for flour and bread sold in any proclaimed area :

Now therefore I, Sir Ronald Craufurd Munro Ferguson, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Board, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Adjustment Order No. 1, and shall come into force on 12th April, 1916.

2. This Order shall apply to the proclaimed area specified in paragraph (c) of the Schedule to the War Precautions (Prices Adjustment) Regulations 1916.

3. The maximum prices which may be charged for bread in the proclaimed area to which this Order applies shall, until further Order, be as follow :—

(a) When purchased at shops or bakehouses and paid for at the time of purchase—

- (i) per 1 lb. loaf, 2d.;
- (ii) per 2 lb. loaf, 3½d.;
- (iii) per 4 lb. loaf, 6½d.;

Provided that when 4 lbs. or over of bread are purchased at the same time the selling price shall be based on that of a 4 lb. loaf.

(b) When delivered and paid for on delivery—

- (i) per 1 lb. loaf, 2½d.;
- (ii) per 2 lb. loaf, 4d.;
- (iii) per 4 lb. loaf, 7d.;

Provided that when 4 lbs. or over of bread are purchased at the same time the selling price shall be based on that of a 4 lb. loaf.

(c) One halfpenny additional to the selling prices set forth in paragraphs (a) and (b) may be charged in respect of each loaf when the sale is booked for one or more days.

### NOTIFICATION OF PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS AND OF THE INTENTION TO MAKE REGULATIONS.

PURSUANT to the *Rules Publication Act* 1903, notice is hereby given—

(1) That His Excellency the Governor-General, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, has been pleased to make Provisional Regulations under the Act named hereunder, to come into operation forthwith.

(2) That it is proposed, after 60 days after the publication of this notice, to make Regulations under that Act, and that the Provisional Regulations above mentioned are drafts of the proposed Regulations.

(3) That copies of the Provisional Regulations may be purchased at the Government Printing Office, Melbourne, at the price indicated.

(4) That any representations or suggestions made in writing by any person interested will be taken into consideration before finally settling the proposed Regulations.
