WAR PRECAUTIONS (PRICES) REGULATIONS 1916.

DETERMINATION OF MAXIMUM PRICES.

Melbourne, 23rd January, 1919.

I, WALTER MASSY GREENE, acting for the Minister of State for Defence, in pursuance of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations 1916, and on the recommendation of the Chief Commissioner for Prices, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 560, and shall come into force on the 24th day of January, 1919.

2. Prices Orders No. 308, made on the 16th May, 1918, and No. 346, made on the 24th June, 1918, are hereby repealed.

3. This Order shall apply to the proclaimed areas specified in the Schedule to this Order.

4. The maximum prices which may be charged for Oatmeal (plain) manufactured in Australia shall, until further order, be as set out in the Schedule to this Order.
