WAR PRECAUTIONS (COAL) REGULATIONS.

ORDER

**Amending Order Varying Contracts for Supply of Coal.**

**W**HEREAS the Acting Prime Minister of the Commonwealth of Australia, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by Regulation 10A of the War Precautions (Coal) Regulations, did, on the sixth day of June, 1919, make an Order varying contracts and agreements for the supply of coal by the owners and lessees of coal mines in the State of New South Wales:

And whereas it is desirable to amend the said Order:

Now therefore, I, William Alexander Watt, the Acting Prime Minister aforesaid, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by Regulation 10A of the War Precautions (Coal) Regulations do hereby amend the said Order by omitting the words "the price specified in the contract or agreement" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "the price prevailing on the first day of May, 1919, for the supply of coal under the contract or agreement."

And I declare that the amendments made by this Order shall take and shall be deemed to have taken effect in respect of all coal delivered under any contract or agreement to which the said Order applies, on or after the fifth day of May, 1919.
