## PROCLAMATION

Australia to wit.

A. L. STANLEY,  
Deputy of the  
Governor-General.

By His Excellency the Deputy of the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by the *Quarantine Act 1908-1915* it is enacted that the Governor-General may, by Proclamation—

(1) Declare that any place in Australia is infected with a quarantinable disease or that a quarantinable disease may be brought or carried from or through that place; and

(2) Declare any part of the Commonwealth in which any quarantinable disease exists to be a Quarantine Area; and

(3) Declare that any persons in any Quarantine Area or in any part of the Commonwealth in which any quarantinable disease exists shall be subject to quarantine:

And whereas a quarantinable disease, to wit, Pneumonic Influenza exists in the State of New South Wales:

Now therefore I, Sir Arthur Lyulph Stanley, the Deputy of the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby declare—

(1) That the State of New South Wales is infected with a quarantinable disease, to wit, Pneumonic Influenza, and is a place from or through which the said quarantinable disease may be brought or carried to other parts of Australia.

(2) That such State shall be a Quarantine Area.

(3) That all persons and goods in such Quarantine Area shall be subject to quarantine.

This Proclamation may be cited as Quarantine Proclamation No. 40.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Commonwealth, this twenty-seventh day of January, One thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and in the ninth year of His Majesty's reign.
