The Enemy Contracts Annulment Act 1915.

WHEREAS by Section 3 of the *Enemy Contracts Annulment Act 1915*, it is provided (*inter alia*) that any party to a contract may file with the Attorney-General of the Commonwealth a copy of the contract, and apply to him for a declaration that the contract is, or is not, an enemy contract within the meaning of that section.

And whereas copies of the contracts set out in the Schedule hereto have been filed with the Attorney-General of the Commonwealth, and applications have been made to him for a declaration that the contracts are, or are not, enemy contracts within the meaning of the said section:

Now therefore I, WILLIAM MORRIS HUGHES, the Attorney-General of the Commonwealth, do hereby declare that the contracts set out in the Schedule hereto are, in so far as they relate to the supply and delivery of the goods set out in the third column of the said Schedule, enemy contracts within the meaning of Section 3 of the *Enemy Contracts Annulment Act 1915*.
