SALE OF MOTOR SCHOONER "SAMOA."

OFFERS will be received up to Wednesday, 31st December, 1919, for the purchase of the schooner *Samoa*, at present in harbor at Port Moresby, Papua.

The vessel is a three-masted topsail schooner, built at Auckland, New Zealand, in 1902, and fitted with a four-cycle Union oil engine, 125 h.p., giving a speed of 7 knots.

Length, 112 feet; beam, 25 feet; depth of hold, 11 feet; gross tonnage, 224; registered tonnage, 162.
