WAR PRECAUTIONS (PRICES) REGULATIONS 1916. AMENDMENT OF PRICES ORDERS.

Melbourne, 6th February, 1919.

I, WALTER MASSY GREENE, acting for the Minister of State for Defence, in pursuance of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations 1916, and on the recommendation of the Chief Commissioner for Prices, do hereby order as follows:—

ORDER No. 572.

DRUGS AND MEDICINES, BUTTER MUSLIN.—COMMONWEALTH.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 572, and shall come into force on the 8th day of February, 1919.
2. This Order shall apply to all proclaimed areas in the various States of the Commonwealth.
3. Prices Orders No. 567, made on the 31st January, 1919, and No. 570, made on the 4th February, 1919, are hereby amended by substituting for the words "generally prevailing," wherever appearing therein, the word "charged".

ORDER No. 573.

REPEAL OF ORDERS.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 573, and shall come into force on the 12th day of February, 1919.
2. All existing Prices Orders in relation to the undermentioned necessary commodity and foodstuffs are hereby repealed:—

Sulphur.
Rabbits.
Biscuits.

DETERMINATION OF MAXIMUM PRICES.

ORDER No. 574.

JAM.—NEW SOUTH WALES.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 574, and shall come into force on the 12th day of February, 1919.
2. Prices Order No. 543, made on the 6th January, 1919, is hereby repealed.

3. This Order shall apply to all proclaimed areas in the State of New South Wales specified in the Schedule to this Order.

4. The maximum prices which may be charged in the proclaimed areas to which this Order applies for Jam manufactured in the State of New South Wales shall, until further order, be as set out in the Schedule to this Order.
