WAR PRECAUTIONS (PRICES) REGULATIONS 1916.

REPEAL OF ORDER.

Melbourne, 13th February, 1919.

I, WALTER MASSY GREENE, acting for the Minister of State for Defence, in pursuance of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations 1916, and on the recommendation of the Chief Commissioner for Prices, do hereby order as follows:—

ORDER No. 575.

### OATMEAL.—COMMONWEALTH.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 575, and shall come into force on the 14th day of February, 1919.
2. All existing Prices Orders in relation to Oatmeal are hereby repealed.

### DETERMINATION OF MAXIMUM PRICES.

Melbourne, 17th February, 1919.

I, WALTER MASSY GREENE, acting for the Minister of State for Defence, in pursuance of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations 1916, and on the recommendation of the Chief Commissioner for Prices, do hereby order as follows:—

ORDER No. 576.

### LINSEED OIL.—COMMONWEALTH.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 576, and shall come into force on the 18th day of February, 1919.
2. Prices Orders No. 430, made on the 12th September, 1918; No. 486, made on the 28th October, 1918; and No. 518, made on the 30th November, 1918, are hereby repealed.
3. This Order shall apply to all the proclaimed areas in the various States of the Commonwealth specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. The maximum prices which may be charged for Linseed Oil shall, until further order, be as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

*Carriage.*—In cases in which, on or before the 1st August, 1914, no charges were made for carriage, &c., no such charges shall now be added to the prices as declared.

Subject to the usual trade allowances, discounts, and delivery.

Where oil is required by the purchaser in containers of a smaller size than those supplied by the manufacturers, the actual cost of such container may be added; provided the amount shall be refunded upon the return of such container to the vendor in good order.
