WAR PRECAUTIONS (PRICES) REGULATIONS 1916.

DETERMINATION OF MAXIMUM PRICES.

Melbourne, 9th April, 1919.

I, WALTER MASSY GREENE, acting for the Minister of State for Defence, in pursuance of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations 1916, and on the recommendation of the Chief Commissioner for Prices, do hereby order as follows:—

ORDER No. 588.

FLOUR.—WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 588, and shall come into force on the 10th day of April, 1919.
2. Prices Order No. 43, made on the 20th September, 1916, is hereby repealed.
3. This Order shall apply to all the proclaimed areas of the State of Western Australia specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. The maximum prices which may be charged for Flour in the areas to which this Order applies, shall, until further order, be as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

ORDER No. 590.

DRUGS AND MEDICINES.—NEW SOUTH WALES.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 590, and shall come into force on the tenth day of April, 1919.
2. So much of Prices Order No. 567, made on the 31st January, 1919, as relates to the proclaimed areas in the State of New South Wales is hereby repealed.
3. This Order shall apply to all proclaimed areas in the State of New South Wales.
4. The maximum prices which may be charged in any area to which this Order applies for the Drugs and Medicines specified in the Schedule to this Order shall, until further order, be as set out in such Schedule.
