WAR PRECAUTIONS (PRICES) REGULATIONS 1916.

DETERMINATION OF MAXIMUM PRICES.

Melbourne, 10th April, 1919.

I, EDWARD JOHN RUSSELL, acting for the Minister of State for Defence, in pursuance of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations 1916, and on the recommendation of the Chief Commissioner for Prices, do hereby order as follows:—

ORDER No. 591.

CAMPHOR.—SOUTH [AUSTRALIA.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 591, and shall come into force on the 11th day of April, 1919.

2. So much of Prices Order No. 567, made on the 31st day of January, 1919, as relates to the price of Camphor in the State of South Australia is hereby repealed.

3. This Order shall apply to all the proclaimed areas in the State of South Australia.

4. The maximum prices which may be charged in any area to which this Order applies for Camphor shall, until further order, be the prices set out in the Schedule hereto.

ORDER No. 592.

CHEESE.—NEW SOUTH WALES.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 592, and shall come into force on the 14th day of April, 1919.

2. So much of Prices Order No. 585, made on the 31st March, 1919, as relates to the State of New South Wales, is hereby repealed.

3. This Order shall apply to all the proclaimed areas in the State of New South Wales specified in the Schedule to this Order.

4. The maximum prices which may be charged for Cheese shall, until further order, be as set out in the Schedule to this Order.
