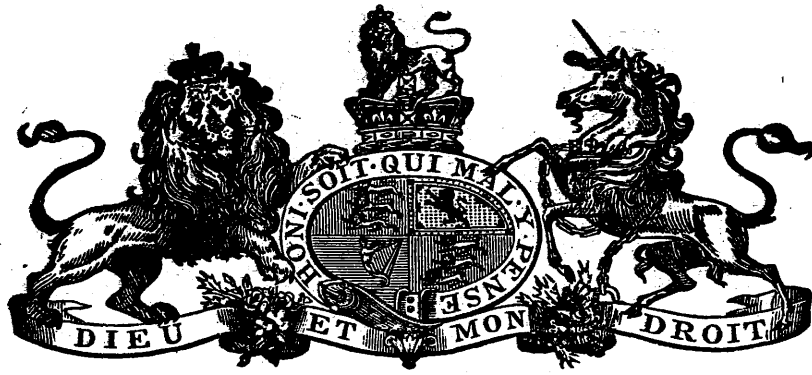

## WAR PRECAUTIONS (COAL) REGULATIONS.

I, ALEXANDER POYNTON, Acting Minister of State for the Navy, in pursuance of the War Precautions (Coal) Regulations (Statutory Rules 1917, No. 195, as amended by Statutory Rules 1917, No. 240 and No. 252), and on the recommendation of the Central Coal Board, do hereby order as follows:—

### Use and Consumption of Gas and Electric Current in the State of Victoria.

On and after Saturday, 7th June, 1919, the use and consumption of gas and electric current by any person in any office, factory, shop, workshop, or warehouse, for other than lighting purposes, are prohibited between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on each day.
